How To Make Veteran's Cemetery And Funeral Arrangements

The Veterans Administration Suggests All Veterans Make Their Arrangements Through The Funeral Home of Their Choice!

Before a Veteran, spouse or dependent can be approved for burial, we must have proof of the veteran's eligibility. The best way to prove eligibility is with documentation of service and discharge, such as the DD form 214. Once eligibility is determined, your benefits would be in affect.

National Cemetery interment includes U.S. government-provided benefits including: a burial plot; assistance with a committal service; opening and closing; a grave liner; a headstone / with inscription and religious symbol; an American flag; perpetual care; and a memorial certificate bearing the President's signature. Funeral services/merchandise not covered.

Grave sites are assigned and cannot be selected in advance. Assignments are made without regard to rank, ethnic or religious back round, branch of service or other factors. A husband and wife are interred in the same plot unless both are veterans. In that case, they may be buried side by side in separate plots.

Almost all veterans are eligible for military honors, which may be requested through the funeral director and are provided by the Department of Defense.

Memorial Plans

Funerals director fees, caskets, urns & cremation services can be prearranged through our Sacred Trust memorial Plan. Our plan allows you to establish eligibility, guarantee all costs, and gain peace of mind, knowing everything is taken care of. All of your personal wishes and information is stored in our protected files. When a death occurs, one phone call and all the arrangements will be automatically taken care of.

Family Protection Gold Card

Once all of your arrangements are complete, you will receive Family Protection Cards. These cards should be carried in your wallet, given to your next of kin, and or your attorney, and even placed on your refrigerator. This makes things a lot easier for the family at the time of need.
