At age three she woke up one day and couldn't walk. She had polio. She spent her early years in and out of the hospital having multiple surgeries. She never let her disability stop her. She went to business school and became a legal secretary for a lawyer.

In her twenties she met the love of her life. They married and years later she was pregnant with her only child. When she was seven months pregnant her husband, who worked at a bank, was killed in a robbery.

A couple years later she met the other love of her life. They married and moved to New Jersey. Later moving to Florida where she would reside for the next 35 years. They were inseparable.

In 2009 she battled and won against stage 3 breast cancer. In 2016 her husband passed. She was never happy after he was gone, but had found a great group of friends where she belonged. She was finally enjoying her life when in March 2023, after a month of severe pains, she was diagnosed with metastatic pancreatic cancer. She choose to fight it with treatment, but in the end she succumbed to the disease. She passed on June 7, 2023. She is survived by her daughter, Brooke (Adam) Persac, grandson Jupiter, and loving family and loyal friends.

She always said she lived a very nice life. She had two wonderful men, a loving daughter, and a wonderful grandson. She couldn't ask for more.
