



## Harold Levine

February 2, 1923 - May 31, 2025

Harold Levine, of Boynton Beach, Florida, passed away peacefully on the morning of May 31, 2025, at the age of 102, with his beloved wife of 83 years, Sylvia, by his side. Born in Brooklyn, New York, Harold was the son of the late Benjamin and Sadie Levine. A proud WWII veteran, Harold served in the United States Navy for three years as a radio operator aboard a ship in the South Pacific, where he communicated in Morse code to assist disabled vessels. While training in Miami with PT boats, he met a young John F. Kennedy, who was recovering from war injuries, a memory Harold fondly recalled for decades. Following his service, Harold dedicated himself to his community and his faith. Deeply proud of his Jewish heritage, he was a longtime supporter of Israel and served as vice president and then president of Hatzilu, where he helped raise funds for indigent Jewish residents in the New York City area. He frequently spoke at synagogues and community events to support those in need, especially those struggling with rent or medical expenses. He also led his local Jewish War Veterans group on Long Island for many years. Harold had a lifelong love for dogs, beginning with his first, Skippy, and generously supported several animal shelters and rescue organizations over the years. He had a successful career in the shoe business, earning the loyalty of his customers and the respect of all who knew him. Above all, Harold was a devoted family man. He is survived by his loving wife, Sylvia; his children, Gary Levine (wife Jill), Sherry Barnett (husband Bruce), Janice Lint (husband Michael), and Bruce Levine (wife Irma); and his

grandchildren, James Levine (wife Jill), Alyssa Firestone (husband Drew), Jon Levine (wife Leigh), Bryan Lint (wife JuMin), Lauren Schneider (husband Jeremy), Jason Barnett (wife Shari), Robert Levine, Samuel Levine, and Sofia Levine. He was also blessed with fifteen great-grandchildren, who brought him endless joy. He leaves behind a legacy of kindness, humor, and unwavering love for his family. His presence will be forever missed, his memory forever cherished, and his life remembered as a true blessing to all who knew him.
