March 8, 1945 - January 27, 2023

With deep sadness, we announce the passing of Warren Deutsch on January 27, 2023.

Born and raised in Passaic, NJ in 1945, he resided there until moving to Wayne, NJ in 1965 and then West Caldwell, NJ in 1973.

An aspiring baseball player, Warren was drafted by the Milwaukee Braves organization before being drafted to the U.S. Army. A proud Veteran, he served the Army between 1966 and 1968 assigned to Fort Dix, NJ and actively deployed to Germany. Upon discharge, Warren owned and operated Deitch Furniture in Passaic, NJ before retiring in 2003.

Since retirement, Warren and his surviving wife of 57 years, Norma, enjoyed retirement in Lake Worth, FL. Warren enjoyed all racquet sports and played actively at the YM/YWHA in Wayne, NJ and the Valencia Shores community in Lake Worth, FL. He enjoyed sports, especially baseball and was an avid fan of the New York Yankees.

Warren was father to two daughters, Robyn Teitel (Todd) of Royal Palm Beach, FL, and Stacy Dymkowski (Joseph) of Wellington, FL. "Papa War" adored his four grandchildren, Jared, Brandon, Rayna, and Asher. He is predeceased by parents, Leah and Saul, and siblings Valerie and Monte.

A memorial service will be held at 12:00 on Tuesday, January 31, 2023 at Sinai Memorial Chapels in Delray Beach, FL. He will be buried at the South Florida National Cemetery in Lake Worth, FL on February 7 at 12:30.
